

Houck Middle School iPad Acceptable Use Agreement

The student agrees to follow these classroom rules:

- I will not chew gum, eat food or drink beverages while electronics are in use.
- I will not change any settings on the iPad.
- I will not access the app store unless directed to by Mrs. Hughes.
- I will not access the Internet without an educational purpose.
- I will not use the camera without an educational purpose.
- I will ask permission before taking photos or videos of another person.
- I will make sure the iPad is properly cared for and put away every day.

iPad Use Policy

Students must follow all school rules as outlined in the Houck Middle School Student/Parent Handbook. Please review the Internet Usage Policy on page 24. It is expected that students will:

- Use technology in a responsible and ethical manner.
- Follow general school rules concerning behavior and communication that apply to technology.
- Use all technology resources in an appropriate manner to not damage school equipment. This damage includes, but is not limited to, the loss of data caused by the student's own negligence, errors or omissions.
- Comply with trademark and copyright laws and all license agreements. Ignorance of the law is not immunity. If you are unsure, ask a teacher or parent.
- Not transmit or access materials that are obscene, offensive, threatening or otherwise intended to harass or demean.

Please be aware that a form must be submitted to the school if you do not want your student using the internet at school (page 24 of the handbook) and a photo/video exclusion form may be filed at Houck's office if you do not want your child photographed or videotaped at school (page 18 of the handbook).

Students and their parents/guardians may be held financially responsible for any technology lost or willfully damaged (District policy INS-A012).
