COURSE GOALS: To further refine and enhance the playing and musical technique of each student through a variety of in class and out of class experiences.

CLASS TIME: We meet everyday from 1:53-2:50 PM. (Periods 11/12)

REQUIRED MATERIALS : 3 Ring Binder Paper Instrument Pencil Music

A Name Tag on Your Instrument Case is Required

GRADING: Grading is based on three areas: Performance, Tests/Quizzes, and Homework. Students can access their current grades online and should see me right away if they have any concerns..

PERFORMANCE: 60%

The performance grade includes classroom performance points, concert performance, and any written assignments that are completed in the classroom. Students are expected to...

- ◆ Be on time to class (This includes setting up their instrument and music in a timely manner)
- ◆ Have all required materials (Instrument, music, notebook, pencil, etc.)
- ◆ Be an attentive and productive member of the orchestra
- ◆ Attend all concerts
- ◆ Attend sectionals and orchestra retreats as scheduled

*Students who miss class due to an excused absence will have one week to make up the time by coming either before or after school to practice in the orchestra room.

CONCERT /EVENT ATTENDANCE:

Concert attendance is mandatory.

Every member in the orchestra is important! We're a team and any one person's absence can be highly disruptive to the performance. Students are required to attend the entire performance which will be a significant portion of the grade. Students who miss a concert due to an excused absence will have the chance to make up the points in a variety of ways at the director's discretion. Examples of make-up work assignments can be provided upon request.

Acceptable reasons for missing a concert are: ILLNESS, RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY, EMERGENCY

In order to qualify as an excused absence, a written note from the parent must be presented to Mrs. Brown before the concert, or if an emergency, within two days after the concert. Email is acceptable.

TESTS and QUIZZES: 25%

This category covers all formal playing tests (pre-recorded or live), all playing quizzes (short snippet tests with advanced notice), and any informal pop quizzes. Any student that does not pass a playing test or quiz must take it again until the material is learned. Students receiving a C or better on a test may take it again at their leisure for a higher grade and by making an appointment to come in before or after school. Written tests also fall into this category.

HOMEWORK: 15%

Practice Cards, listening assignments, or any extra musical assignment (music compositions, special reports, etc..) that is completed outside of class time will fall under this category.

WILD CARD (or Extra Credit)

Extra credit can be earned in many different ways. Below are just some examples for students wishing to increase their classroom grade. Students can always run other ideas by me to see if they count as well.

The concert is filmed and aired on CCTV. **It is an honor to be selected into this group!** I highly encourage all of my students to audition and any student willing to do this will be given extra instruction from myself and extra credit for taking the audition.

OMEA DISTRICT IV SOLO and ENSEMBLE:

This event is for students wishing to perform and be critiqued on their solos or as a group of students. This is a wonderful opportunity for students to challenge themselves and to get feedback on their playing from someone other than their regular teacher.

Any student or student groups wishing to perform at this event will receive extra instruction from myself and extra credit.

LOCAL AREA PERFORMANCE GROUPS:

In Salem, we have several area performance groups offering concerts all the time! A list of these groups will be handed out during class.

In addition, the Oregon Symphony performs in Salem and offers students discounted tickets. It's a great opportunity to see a professional orchestra right here at home!

PRIVATE LESSONS

There are many fine independent teachers in the Salem area. If you are interested in taking private lessons, Mrs. Brown can provide you with a list of resources to get you started on your search. Benefits to taking lessons include learning at a faster rate on your instrument, one on one instruction with a qualified musician, and it can make you more competitive when the time comes for applying for college admittance and scholarships.
